

Field Label Positioning

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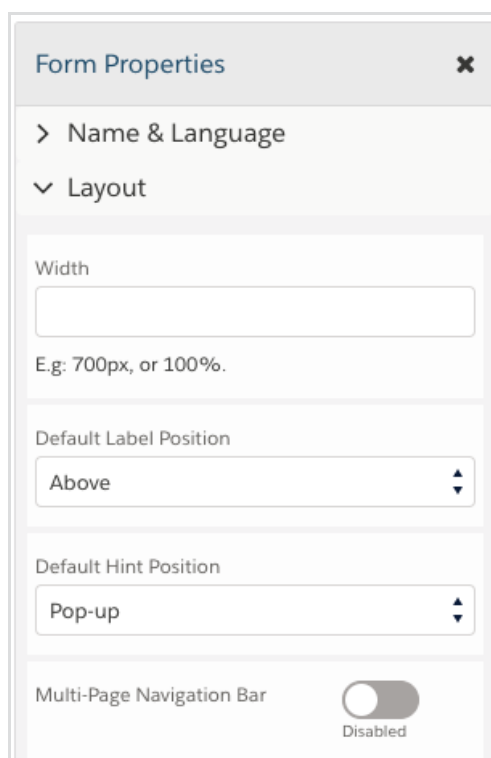
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In the **Layout** settings of the Form Properties menu, you may select the form's settings for the placement of the hints and labels. You can also enable the Navigation Bar on multi-page forms.

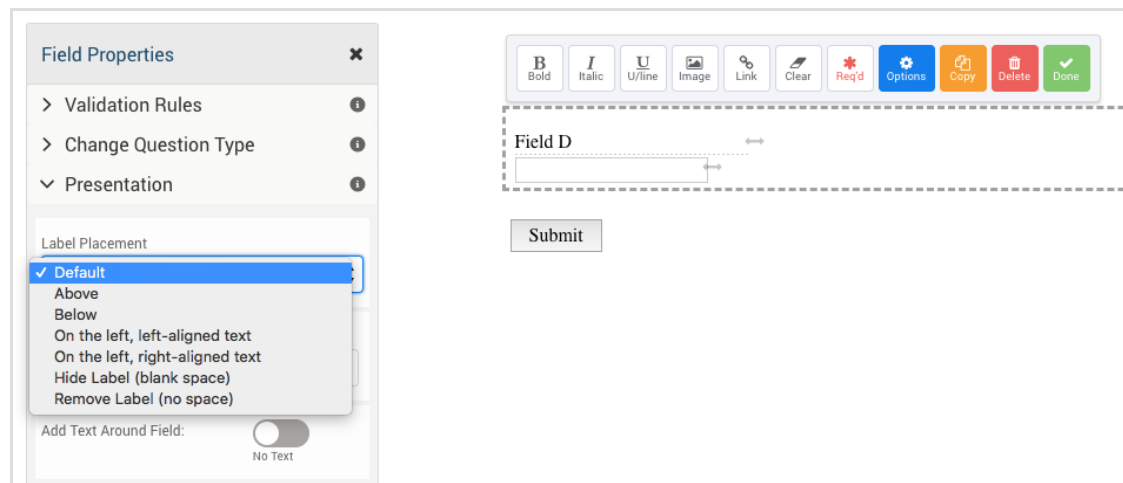

Position Individual Field Labels

To change the position of the label of an individual question:



1. Select your question and click the **Options** button to open the editing sidebar.
2. Select **Presentation** from the sidebar.
3. Select your label placement preference from the **Label Placement** drop-down menu.

Hiding vs. Removing the Label

Tip: Do not delete labels. Instead, give them a name before hiding or removing them. This will make them easier to reference in the outline view and in your connectors.

Removing a label will hide the space saved for the label.

Hiding a label will hide the label text, but the space where the text would show will still be there.
