

# Add Text Around Fields

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### Introduction


Adding text around a field can be helpful when you need something displayed before a value. For example, you can add  before a numeric value on a form.

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## Steps

To add text around a field:

1. Select the field.
2. Select the **Options** button.
3. Select the **Presentation** tab.
4. At the bottom of the Presentation section, enable the **Add Text Around Field** option.
5. You can add text *before* or *after* the field. If you would only prefer one, you can also delete the text before or after the field to remove it.
